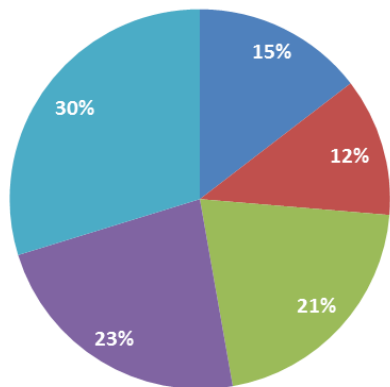

Where Respondents Live

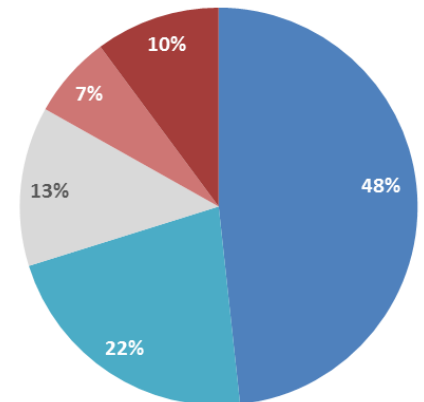


■ On the route ■ Within 1 block ■ Within 2-4 blocks

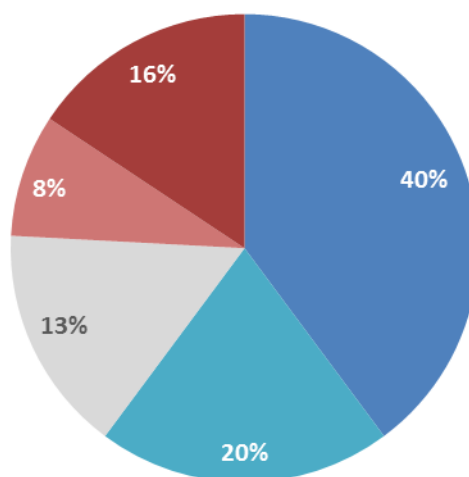
