

# PENN-OLIVER AVE S WEB UPDATE—June 30

*\*Please note that construction schedules and operations are controlled by the contractor and are subject to change based on weather and construction progress.*

## **June 30, 2017**

### **Week of June 26**

Phase 1 (the west side of Oliver Ave from Douglas to Franklin) neared completion this week, and Phase 2 concrete repairs began. The Phase 2 area includes the east side of Penn Ave S from 21st St W to W Lake of the Isles Pkwy.

### **Week of July 3—Happy 4<sup>th</sup> of July!**

*Please note that crews will not work on July 4.*

Phase 1 and Phase 2 concrete repairs will continue. The west lane of Penn Ave from 21<sup>st</sup> to W Lake of the Isles Pkwy will remain open to southbound traffic.

1. Although southbound traffic will remain open on the west side of the Phase 2 area, drivers may experience temporary delays when machinery pours concrete. Crews will do their best to accommodate drivers when this occurs.

## PHASE 2

Phase 2 will include work along the east side of Penn-Oliver Ave from 21<sup>st</sup> St W to West Lake of the Isles Pkwy. Southbound traffic only will be allowed along the west side of the Phase 2 street, and NO PARKING signs will be posted between 21<sup>st</sup> and Lake of the Isles Pkwy. The entire project began on June 19 and is expected to be completed by August 18. Future phases of the work will be detailed in upcoming newsletters.
